DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Travel with the family both domestically and internationally, which can be both short and long term and can be last minute.
- The position is Toronto-based, however, summer months are spent in Muskoka for varying lengths of time
- Support parents and parenting choices while interfacing with the parents.
- Report to the Estate Manager.
- Plan both active and educational activities (indoors and outdoors).
- Create a fun and safe environment for the home and children.
- Participate with the children in sporting activities that will include swimming, skate, ski, play tennis, and water sports.
- When required must be able to work evenings, occasional overnighting (to cover for the overnight nanny when needed), and holidays.

- While there is a Chef, there will be preparation of some meals.
- Maintaining and organizing childrens' wardrobes as well as doing childrens' laundry.

- When time permits, help other staff in their duties.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Previous childcare experience with a private family (at least five years) in a similar position is required.

- Strong English language communication skills (written and verbal).
